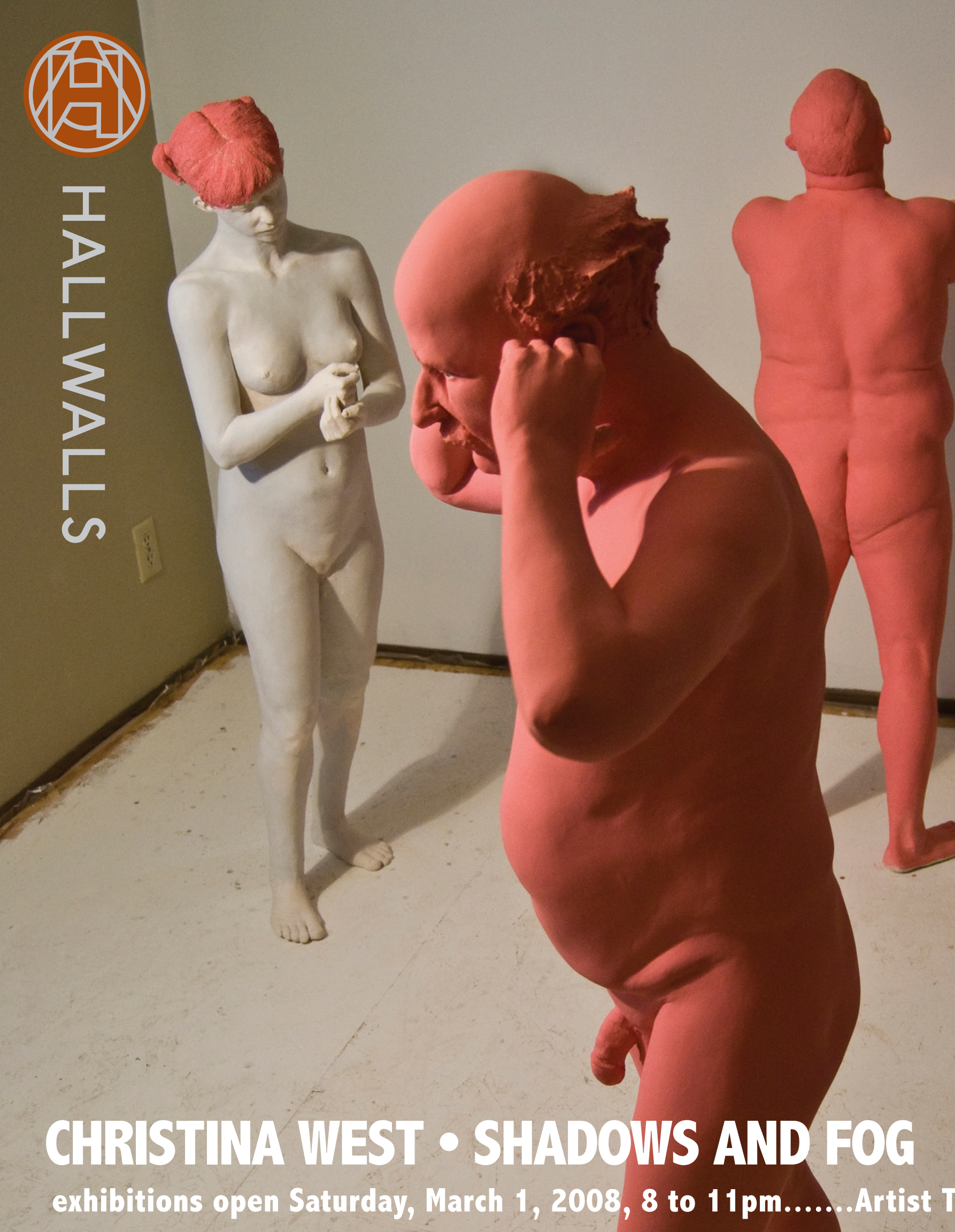

THE WORK OF THE MUSICIAN: Double Feature

Hallwalls celebrates the work of two eminent musicians who have recently graced our stage. In MUSICIAN (2007, 60min), filmmaker Daniel Kraus documents Chicago luminary Ken Vandermark, an avant-garde improvisational reed player widely admired for his fierce work ethic. The documentary, which is part of the larger WORK film series, features footage from the road, including a stop at Hallwalls in summer 2006 when Vandermark performed with CINC.

The film will be preceded by MARC RIBOT: DESCENT INTO BALDNESS (1993, 33min), German filmmaker Cassis Blush's documentary which uses a captivating blend of experimental techniques to record the guitarist's life, work, and art.
