**NAOMI UMAN: UKRANIAN TIME MACHINES**

FORMER HARP ARTIST NAOMI UMAN RETURNS TO HALLWALLS FROM EASTERN EUROPE. HOPING TO EXPERIENCE WHAT IT IS LIKE TO BE AN IMMIGRANT, THE FILMMAKER MOVED TO THE UKRAINE SHORTLY AFTER HER 2005 RESIDENCY—A REVERSE JOURNEY TAKEN BY HER GREAT-GRANDPARENTS IN 1906. 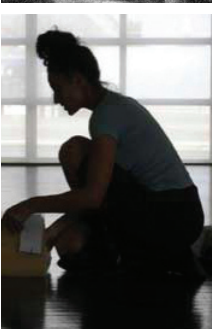
